

Course Description

Grade 5 Bible

Philosophy Statement: Through the teaching and study of God's Word, we desire to equip students to know the fullness of God, to pursue His truth, and glorify Him in word and deed. (Ephesians 3:16-17).

Course Objective: To present the Bible as the story of God's acts and words, written so that his people might know God. To teach the Bible not as a history book, or a rule book, but as the divinely inspired and infallible Word of God, each part of which has a particular purpose and fits into the overall purpose of the Bible. To help students make an informed commitment to Christ as Savior and Lord and to live out that commitment through love, obedience, and service in ways appropriate for their spiritual maturity. To immerse students in the stories and other writings in the Bible so that they may grow in knowledge, wisdom, sensitivity, and creativity.
