Instructional

- Assists teachers in developing and providing academically advanced students with alternative course work through curriculum modification, acceleration, etc.
- Establishes and maintains open lines of communication with students and their parents concerning the broad academic and behavioral progress of all assigned students.
- Remains current with instructional best practices and research to support the needs of academically advanced students
- Provides support for faculty and students in developing and implementing problem-based learning, STEAM and other innovative learning opportunities.
- Models innovative learning practices which could include co-teaching with other teachers.
- Coaches teachers on methodologies and best practices that can be used to deliver content.

Assessments & Reporting

- Utilizes assessment data as the basis for guiding instructional improvement.
- Completes progress reports on each student as needed.
- Documents ongoing consultation with classroom teachers and maintaining a record of modified instructional strategies and results for each student where appropriate.
